



## Resolution X

The Circle of Presidents of the Conference of European Constitutional Courts, having convened to the Preparatory Meeting of the XIVth Congress of the Conference of European Constitutional Courts on 7 September 2006 in Vilnius,

Taking account of the proposals of the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Lithuania concerning:

1. The adoption of the Amendments and Supplements to the Statute of the Conference of European Constitutional Courts,
2. The adoption of the Amendments and Supplements to the Regulations of the Conference of European Constitutional Courts,

Having heard the speech of Egidijus Kūris, President of the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Lithuania concerning the proposed questions,

Having heard the assenting and dissenting opinions of the participants of the Preparatory Meeting, as well as the proposals to form a Commission for the amendments to the Statute,

Having held that a majority of not less than two-thirds of votes of members participating in the meeting, as required by Article 9.7a of the Statute, has not approved of the decisions to consider the Amendments and Supplements to the Statute and Regulations and to form a Commission for the amendments to the Statute,

has resolved:

1. Not to consider the proposed Amendments and Supplements to the Statute and Regulations of the Conference of European Constitutional Courts

2. Not to approve of the formation of a Commission for the amendments to the Statute.
